Cotati Curbside Cleanup

Week of May 21st - May 25th, 2018

Free of charge – Cotati <u>residential customers in good standing</u> may place clean-up materials from their homes (contained in bags or boxes) at the curb for collection, during the week of May 21st – May 25th, 2018. Please follow all requirements listed below in <u>order to</u> ensure collection.

Requirements:

- . Items must be at the curb by 6am on the regularly scheduled service day
- · Each residence is allowed:
 - o 14 bags, boxes, or cans of refuse OR,
 - o 7 bags, boxes, or cans of refuse AND 1 bulky item OR,
 - o 2 bulky items
 - o Excess materials will not be collected
- · All items must weigh less than 50 pounds
 - o No construction and demolition debris
 - o No liquids, cement, dirt, or asphalt
 - No mattresses or large appliances
- Loose items will not be collected
 - o All material must be contained
 - Yard trimmings must be less than 3" in diameter & 3' long, and must be bundled
- Hazardous waste will not be collected
 - o No propane tanks, batteries, cleaners, paint, medications, etc.
 - No pressure treated wood, tires, televisions, or e-waste

MAY IS BIKE TO WORK MONTH!

Sonoma County, CA -- May is National Bike to Work Month, created by the League of American Cyclists in 1956 as a way to promote the benefits of bicycling and encourage more folks to give it a try. Cycling to work reduces carbon emissions and traffic congestion, improves physical and mental health, and saves money...plus, it's fun!

Throughout the month of May, the <u>Sonoma County Bicycle Coalition</u> (SCBC) is offering activities to support those willing to give commuting on two wheels a try.

Do you need a little encouragement to get started? Drop by their office at 750 Mendocino Avenue between 10 am and 1 pm on Saturday, April 28 for a <u>FREE bike clinic</u>. Their certified instructors will provide free bike safety inspections and minor adjustments, and help fit your helmet correctly. You can test bikes from the Coalition's Bike Lending Library, practice safety drills and get advice on route planning and gear. Coffee, snacks, and free bicycle maps will be available.

Do you enjoy a little friendly competition? Does having teammates spur you to action? Join the Bay

Area Bike Challenge! Create or join a team to compete for the most miles ridden throughout the month. A handy smartphone app will automatically track your rides. Sign up at www.lovetoride.net/bayarea.

Or simply sign the online <u>Pledge to Ride on Bike to Work Day</u> – you'll receive helpful tips by email weekly AND be entered in a drawing to win cool prizes!

On Bike to Work Day, May 10, <u>Energizer Stations</u> are set up during the morning commute (6-9 am) along cycling routes throughout the county, offering riders snacks, swag, and encouragement. It's a party on two wheels! Check out the interactive map on bikesonoma.org for the station nearest your home or workplace. Then, celebrate your achievement after work with an after-party at 2Tread Brewing in the Santa Rosa Plaza Mall.
