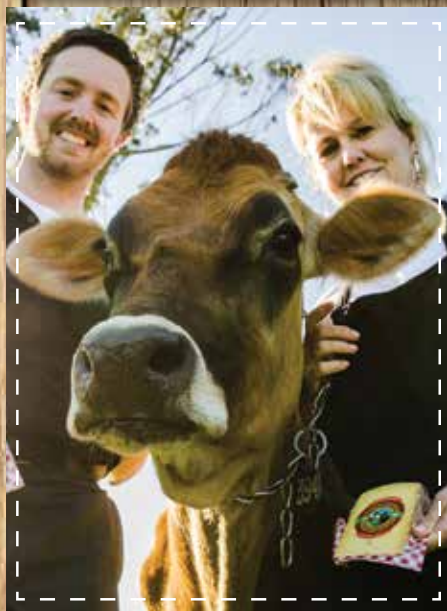

All Accordions, All Day Long

This year, Cotati will celebrate the 30th Anniversary of the Cotati Accordion Festival, Saturday and Sunday, August 22-23 at La Plaza Park in downtown Cotati.

Celebrating the 30th anniversary of anything is impressive, but to have an annual event that attracts almost 5,000 people for two days is quite an accomplishment. Toting blankets and chairs and in many cases accordions, enthusiastic attendees at the Cotati Accordion Festival have helped put Cotati on the map in the accordion world. The event draws aficionados and fans alike from across the nation.

But this is not an event just for old-timers—although they'll be there too.

"There has been a subtle shift to the Accordion Festival, becoming a 'cool' event for millennials. They come for the music, energy and fun. More and more every year," says Scott Goree, Executive Director of the Festival.

This year, the Accordion Festival extravaganza falls on Saturday and Sunday, August 22-23 at La Plaza Park in downtown Cotati. The first band starts at 9:45, but the lines begin to form by 7 a.m. With so many people at the park, and more than 70 vendors, it's worth rising early to get the perfect seat. This is a special year for Goree and Festival Producer Linda Conner, who work year round

preparing for this massive two-day event as they celebrate one of the longest running accordion festival in the U.S. By the time the Festival begins, more than 150 community volunteers have come together to make the weekend a success!

This year's lineup includes more than 40 soloists and bands including Alex Miexner, the most popular accordion player in the country; Cory Pesaturo, best jazz accordionist in the United States; Weronika Sura, world-class soloist from Poland; Joe Natoli, one of the top 10 American players; The Great Morgani, the costumed soloist; Erica Marie Mancini, NYC aerialist; Sourdough Slim, the yodeling cowboy; The Future Stars and Jim Gilman.

Combos and bands include Royal Jelly Jive; Bela Ciao; Mad Maggies; Those Darn Accordions; Pistoleros Famosas, Santa Rosa's young latino group; Steve Balich Polka Band; Debra Peters and Rosie Flores playing rock-a-billy; Motordude Zydeco and so many more.

"In the first year of the Festival in 1991 it was difficult finding musicians who were willing to work for almost nothing. Look ahead 30 years and bands are clamoring to be included. Everyone wants to play at the Cotati Accordion Festival, says Goree.

There are multiple stages throughout the park and in town where musicians perform or other activities take place. The Polka tent for dancing is always popular. Zydeco dance lessons at Friar Tucks in downtown Cotati draw a crowd. Also, there are two main stages, side-by-side and a jam tent for anyone who wants to join in. The Traveling Spectacular Stage is where Indie/avant garde/millennial acts gather to entertain.

The various genres of music (Zydeco, Polka, Norteno and others) draw crowds of all cultural backgrounds and definitely multi-generational; many kids and millennials are in the crowds.

One of the many activities bringing both performers and the audience together is the daily massive group rendition of The Lady of Spain. Dozens crowd the main stage areas around 1:30 each day to join in. The energy can be heard for blocks!

Also, each year, a Student Scholarship competition for kids ages 4-16 encourages young players and help fund their lessons and studies. The competition is on stage, Saturday between 9:30 am and noon, at the Church of the Oaks. Winners are announced on one of the main stages mid-day on Saturday. This is the 7th year that donations from generous community members have helped fund the scholarships. Young players will also be on stage in the park.

"People have told us they plan their annual vacations around the Accordion Festival, traveling from near and far, with their

RVs to take part in this two-day extravaganza of music, fun and meeting up with friends," says Conner. About half the attendees travel to get there; the others are locals. "We're very pleased about that."

The Festival is much more than just music, fun, camaraderie and dancing. It's also an orga-

nization that supports multiple community groups. Both Goree and Conner are proud of the fact that the Festival has, over its history, donated almost \$500,000 to local nonprofits including the Education Foundation that benefits Cotati schools, the music program at Thomas Page Academy, the annual camping trip of the Boy Scouts Troop 4, the playground at the Cotati-Rohnert Park Co-op Nursery School and as a major supporter of the out-door programs at Pengrove Elementary School.

Tickets are on sale at cotatifest.com. Low-back chairs and blankets are welcome, as is water. Everything else is not allowed,



but are for sale at dozens of vendor booths stationed around the park. Under 15 are free with a paying adult; adults \$19 for one day (\$17 advance) or \$29 for both days (Advance \$27). Senior discounts are available. Shuttles will pick up at the Park & Ride and the SMART train station in Cotati throughout the day. Complete information at cotatifest.com or call 707 664-0444.

The CIT program is designed to prepare and train young adults to become future Camp Counselors. This training will provide the CIT with a hands-on practical experience laying the foundation for development of skills necessary to become a future Camp Counselor. The CIT will be working with children ages 5 to 12 years old. While this training is specific to summer camps, the CIT will find aspects of the training that may be applied to any job. Specifically, the CIT will learn the following:

- How to plan and implement large and small group activities
- How to manage small groups of children
- Basic techniques of positive reinforcement and discipline
- Basic techniques of behavior management

CITs will be trained with the oversight of a City of Cotati employee and will be given the opportunity to grow and improve. While the City of Cotati does intend on training a CIT to become a future Camp Counselor, participation in the CIT program is in no way a guarantee for future employment. Please send your child with snacks each day. Lunch is available at camp for no extra fee.

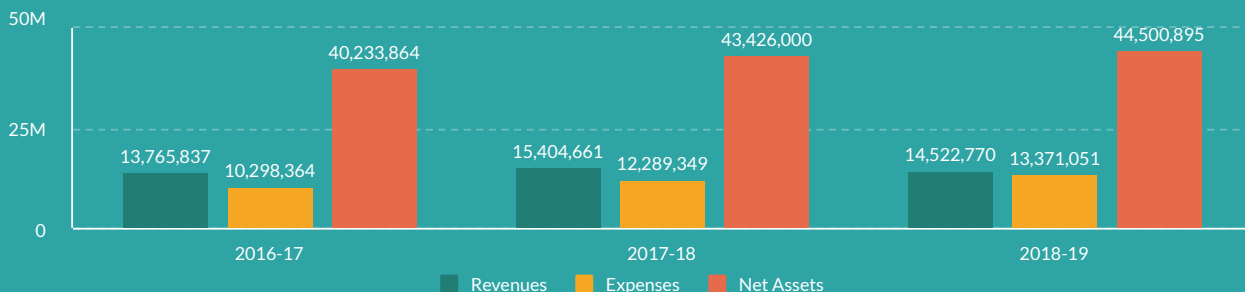

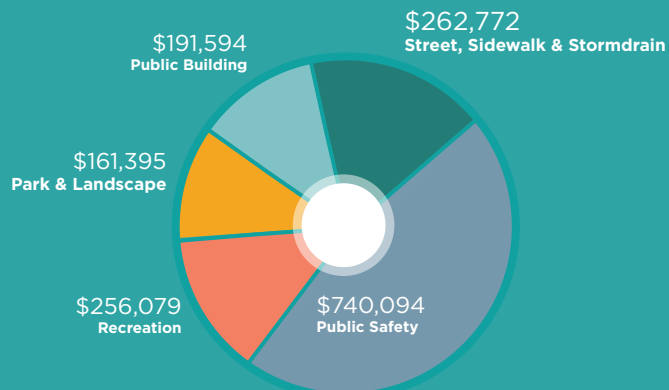

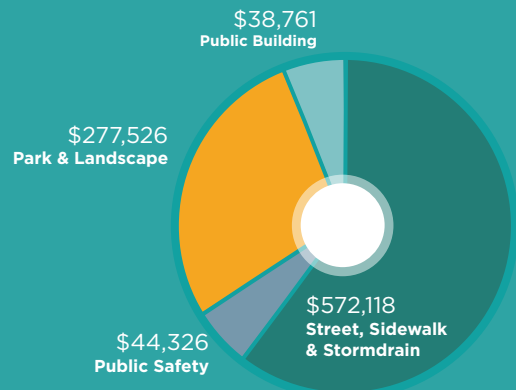
